



GUIDELINES FOR INDOOR VISITATION

Please note that while the facility will permit structured indoor visitation to residents, we continue to recommend that visits occur outdoors. It is a fact that the risk of transmission of coronavirus is reduced when outdoors and increased inside a closed environment.

Indoor visitation privileges are contingent upon following the requirements below, which reflect the measures the facility has deemed necessary to protect the health and safety of facility residents and staff:

1. You must completely read the Coronavirus Basic Information, print, and sign the page, and bring it to the facility at your first visit.
2. Social distancing of six feet must be maintained between visitor and resident. There can be no physical contact between the visitor or the resident.
3. There will be no more than two (2) visitors per resident visit. No children under the age of 13 are permitted at this time.
4. All visitors must have their temperature taken and complete the COVID-19 screening form prior to the visit. Visitors who have a temperature > 99.8 or who have positive answers to the screening form will not be permitted to visit. Any visitor assessed as unwell by a licensed nurse must leave the facility immediately.
5. All visits are monitored by staff, and the monitor is responsible to provide reminders and feedback to the visitor as necessary to maintain resident safety. The monitor may end any visit if they determine that resident or visitor behavior is compromising health and safety.
6. All visitors must supply and wear a face mask and sanitize their hands upon arrival to the facility. You may not enter the building without a mask.
7. Visitors must go directly to the designated visitation area. NO visitation takes place outside of that area and you may not have contact with other residents.

8. There can be no eating or drinking during the visit. Your face mask must stay in place and cover both your nose and your mouth. Removal of a face mask will result in the immediate end of your visit.

9. Visitors are to observe the time limitations for the visit appointment. This permits other residents and family to share the visitation experience.
