

Visitation Guidance

- ❖ Visitors must wear a mask covering both nose and mouth; scarves and bandanas are not acceptable substitutions. Your nose and mouth must remain covered the entire time you are in the facility.
- ❖ We strongly encourage visits to be outside when the weather is appropriate. This is a safer, lower risk environment.
- ❖ Visitors must observe six feet of social distancing.
- ❖ Visitation occurs only in the resident's room or apartment. Visitors must go directly to the room and cannot visit or be present in common areas of the facility.
- ❖ Visitors are limited to two.
- ❖ We are happy to test you for COVID-19 at your request. The test consists of a nasal swab and the results are available in 15 minutes. You will wait to receive results before visiting, so plan for this time.
- ❖ You will have your temperature taken, and will not be permitted to visit if you have a fever or other symptoms of illness.
- ❖ It is recommended that any visits involving pets or small children take place outside whenever possible.
- ❖ Actions by a visitor that pose a risk to staff or other residents may result in the visitor being asked to leave the facility, for example: failure to wear a mask, failure to maintain social distances, or entering common areas.
